snowshoe lessons are a fun thing to do.



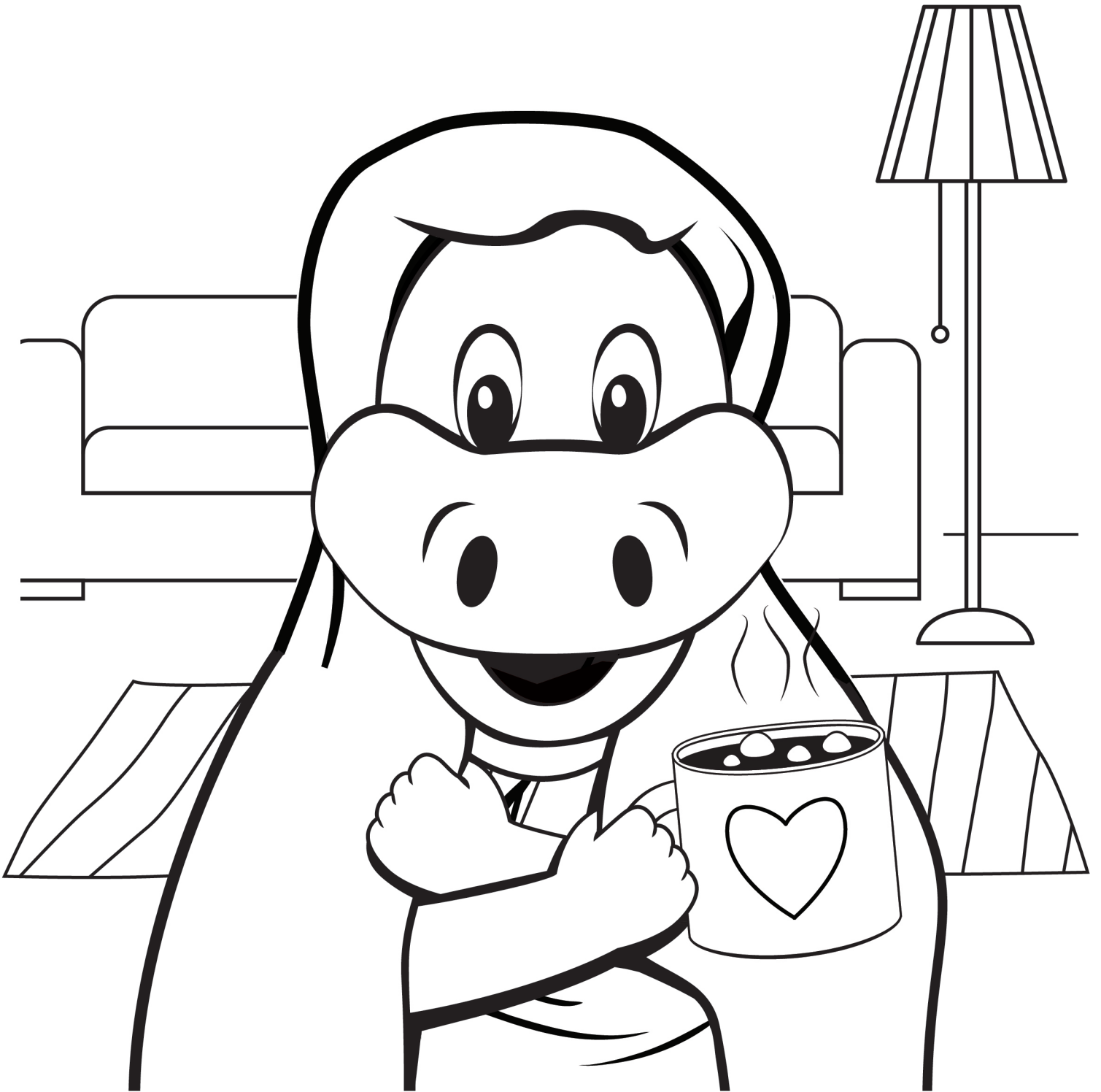


Dexter went to his local sledding hill.

The trail was so scenic with snow covered trees.

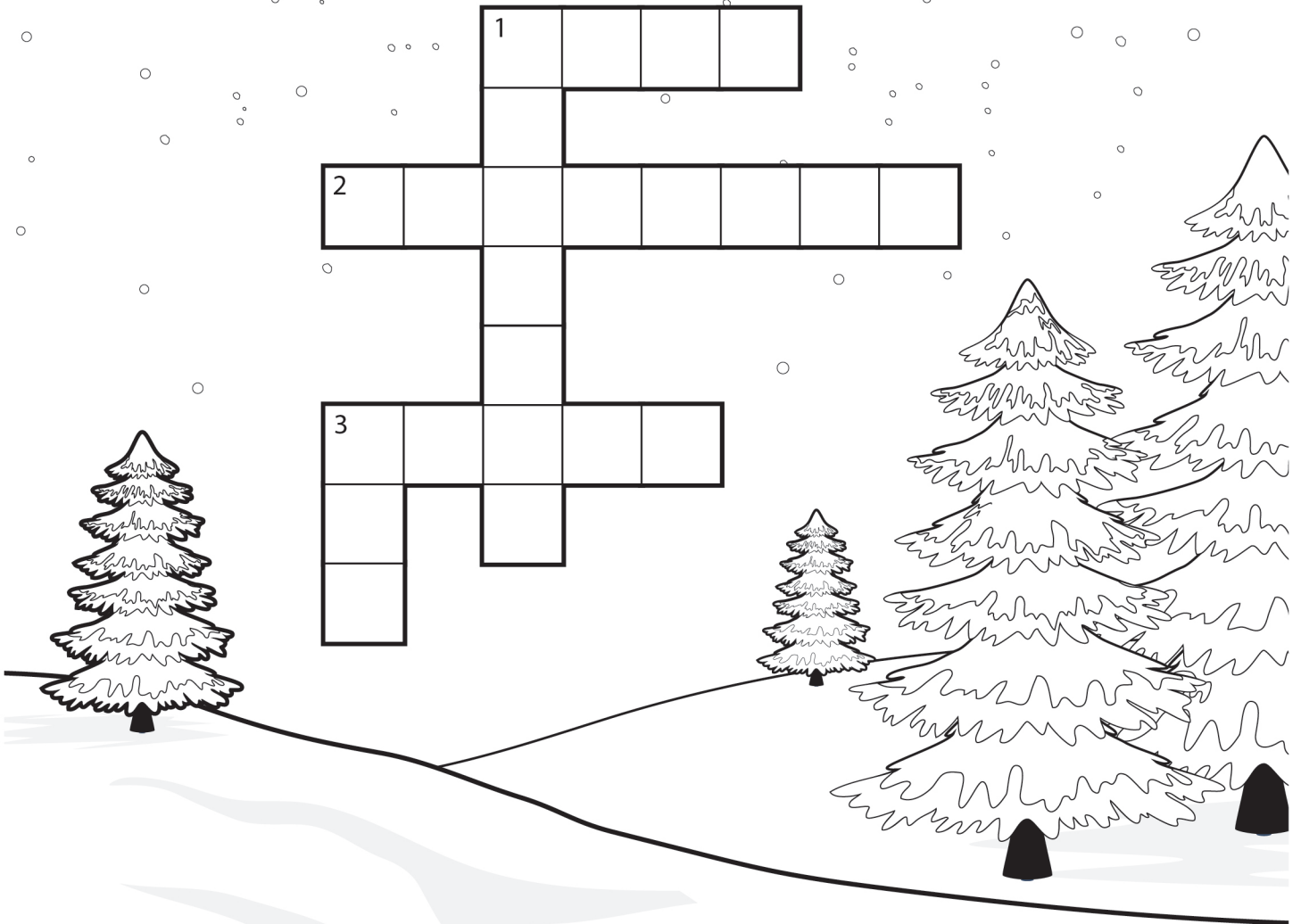
Back home Dexter recalled all the things he'd done.
